



- > ADANI PORT BECOMES 2<sup>ND</sup> LARGEST PORT AMONG INDIAN COMMERCIAL PORTS (POP) BOTH IN BULK AND CONTAINER CARGO SEGMENTS.
- > SIGNED CONCESSION AGREEMENT WITH THE KANDLA PORT TRUST, TO SET UP A BULK TERMINAL AT THE KANDLA PORT.
- > EMERGED AS THE ONLY PRIVATE SECTOR PORT OPERATOR WITH PRESENCE ACROSS SIX PORTS IN INDIA.
- > HANDLED 17.42 MMT CARGO 9% GROWTH (POP) & ITS MARKET SHARE IMPROVED TO 11% FROM 10% (POP).
- > HANDLED HIGHEST CONTAINER VOLUME 430429 25% GROWTH (POP) & MARKET SHARE IN CONTAINER IMPROVED TO 18% FROM 15% (POP).






Multi purpose Terminal 3 - Berth No 9 - 12



#### Corporate Social Responsibilities

#### 1. Adani Foundation under Education program initiatives:

- → 18 Education Volunteers provided their services to more than 36 schools of 19 villages of Mundra Taluka benefitting about 6,600 students.
- → More than 40 students from Kelai Wadi School (Moti-Bhaujpur) participated in Meena Balmela.
- → More than 220 mothers participated in Meena mother's meet with focus on involvement of mothers during vacations and to facilitate admission process of children.
- → 7 villages and more than 185 beneficiaries covered under Meena Street Library, at Kukadsar which was started with 15 children.
- → More than 180 children participated in Meena Vacation Camps (with the help of glove puppets) arranged by trained Education Volunteers of Adani Foundation.
- ⇒ Celebrating 39th "World Environment" total 39,000 trees were planted with the help of horticulture department.

#### 2. Adani Foundation under Community Health initiatives:

- → Mobile Dispensaries provided cashless medical services to 13,886 patients, rural clinics treated 14,240 patients.
- → Adani Medical Centre, established primarily for truckers & cleaners, treated 1,350 patients.
- → Provided financial support of Rs 3.5 Lacs 22 Patients.
- → Kidney Stone: Awareness, Prevention & treatment During this quarter, 53 patients of Kidney Stone were served, 15 patients from the same undergone Surgery. Total 154 patients underwent Surgery.
- ⇒ Senior Citizen Health Card/ Vadil Swasthya Yojana this project has coverage of more than 3,200 Sr. Citizens offering cashless medical services up to 75,000 per person for three years.



- 3. Adani Foundation under Sustainable Livelihood Development initiatives:
  - ⇒ Support to Fisherman Communities Fish Vending material support was provided to 51 Women of Luni and Shekhadia Villages
  - ⇒ Income Generation Support given to 5 needy Fisherman Families amounting Rs. 40,000
  - ⇒ provided Computer System- 10 sets & LCD-(42 inches screen) to Luni SMJ High school
  - → Providing alternative livelihood to the fisherfolk during their off season in the form of Mangroves Nursery Development & Plantation, AF generated employment of 815 man days proving compensation amounting Rs. 1,63,000
- 4. Adani Foundation under Sustainable Livelihood Development initiatives:
  - → Adani Foundation under Rural Infrastructure Development initiatives created/ refurbished infrastructure facilities at various village locations as follows:
    - Construction of Gaushala (Baroi)
    - Construction of Fencing and Wood Store-room (Kukadsar)
    - Cricket Ground (Bhadreshwar)
    - Construction of Prayer Shed (Sadau)
    - Construction of Prayer Shed (Moti Khakhar)
    - Cricket Ground (Moti Khakhar)
