Subject: Addendum of trade circular no. APSEZL/Marine/23/2021 dated 6<sup>th</sup> August 2021 on Mandatory Requirement of laser Range-finder guns on board for Container vessels with LOA greater than 270 Mtrs.

Dear Sirs,

In respect to our trade circular no. APSEZL/Marine/23/2021 dated 6<sup>th</sup> August 2021 we have received feedback from our valued customers that APSEZ should make arrangements for deploying the LRF (Laser Range Finder) on board if vessels do not have LRF.

In the view of above please find addendum of our trade circular no. APSEZL/Marine/23/2021 dated  $6^{\text{th}}$  August 2021 on mandatory requirement of laser range-finder gun on board.

- 1. Pilot shall be bringing LRF (Laser Range Finder) 2 in number on board vessel and hand over to the Master of the vessel for further use at the stations Fwd & Aft.
- 2. Agent should make LRF arrangement request to Port with minimum 2 hrs. Notice through mail if LRF is not available on vessel.
- 3. Once movement of the vessel completed, master shall hand over the Port's LRF back to Pilot.
- 4. Any damage or loss of the LRF incurred while in use or while in possession, charges of \$500 per LRF shall be applicable.
- 5. Port will charge \$ 100 per / VCN for using Port's LRF on board.
- 6. The above charges will not be applicable to the vessels which will use their own LRF for the manoeuvring.

This should be strictly for compliance and will be in force from 15<sup>th</sup> Sept 2021.
