Subject: Ban on usage of Thuraya, Iridium and other such Satellite Communications In Indian waters.

Further to DGS order No. 02 Of 2012 dated 17<sup>th</sup> May 2012 regarding banning of the use of Thuraya, Iridium and other such non-Inmarsat satellite phones in Indian waters, all agents are advised to inform ships coming under their agency to ensure strict compliance of the above-mentioned DGS order.

All vessels are henceforth required to provide the following details 96 hours prior their arrival to Dighi port along with pre-arrival information on e-mail id: [dpl.radio@adani.com](mailto:dpl.radio@adani.com) and copy to [dpl.marine@adani.com](mailto:dpl.marine@adani.com) besides their statutory declaration in the Pre- Arrival Notification on Security (PANS).
