Trade notice - Per Arrival Notification of security (PANS)

Dear Sir,

It has been brought to the notice of the Port by regulatory Government Authorities that, on some occasions, vessels have entered Indian territorial waters without submitting PANS to Ports and other nominated authorities. This is in contravention of DG shipping circulars on the subject.

It is therefore requested that Pre-Arrival Notification of Security (PANS) be submitted within the time limit as given in the above circulars. Failure to submit the PANS as per regulation will result in the vessel being denied entry into the Port waters.

- 1. The PANS shall be submitted 96 hours prior to arrival of the vessel at any Indian ports. If the voyage is shorter than 96 hours then it shall be submitted within 2 hours of departure from the last port. This also applies to vessels trading in coastal waters or coasting between Indian ports.
- 2. The above requirement comes into effect from the date of issuance of this circular.
