To, Shipping Agents, APSEZ, Mundra.

Subject: Declaration of Gross Tonnage during the vessel declaration.

In the past we have observed that the Gross tonnage of some of the vessels are changed due to structural changes of vessel and amended tonnage certificate is not submitted to the port by vessel/agent before the next call immediately after the amendment in the tonnage certificate. Late submission of the amended tonnage certificate is causing the concern in billing of the vessel.

To avoid the above ambiguity, Agent has to verify the Gross tonnage with Master prior declaration of vessel and submit latest tonnage certificate to the Port. In case of any wrong or late declaration of the amended Gross tonnage, it will be consider as "Wrong declaration of Gross tonnage".

All the previous completed voyage invoices under the declaration of the old gross tonnage after the date of issue of the amended tonnage certificate will be revised as per the amended Gross tonnage.

Above trade notice is applicable with immediate effect.
