Subject: LSFO Regulations as per Marpol Annex VI

0.50% max limit of the Sulphur content in fuel Oil-Compliance with provisions of MARPOL Annex VI Regulation 14.1.3

As per latest Marpol regulation "The sulphur content of any fuel oil used on board all ships shall not exceed 0.50% m/m on and after 1 January 2020". The interpretation of "fuel oil used on board" includes use in main and auxiliary engines and boilers.

Ships may meet the SOx emission requirements by using approved equivalent methods, such as exhaust gas cleaning systems or "scrubbers", which "clean" the emissions before they are released into the atmosphere. In this case, the equivalent arrangement must be approved by the ship's Administration (the flag State). Valid Certification and discharge methods should be available for verification and checks.

Vessel has to comply with all international regulations and ensure no pollution in port limits. Vessel should also have valid statutory certificates and documents pertaining to Marpol Annex VI Regulation 14.

Vessels could be inspected by Port Authority / Port State wrt to Marpol Annex. VI compliance.

Agencies are requested to circulate to all stakeholders and visiting ships under their agencies.
