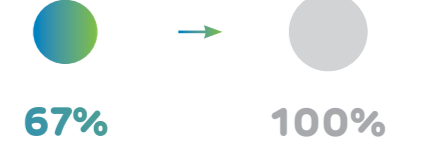
ESG Assessment of Tier 1, Critical and Monopoly Vendors



Vendor Satisfaction Score

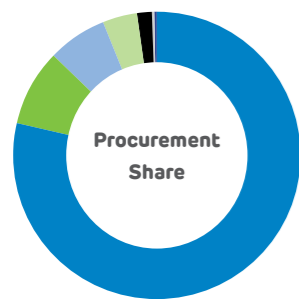
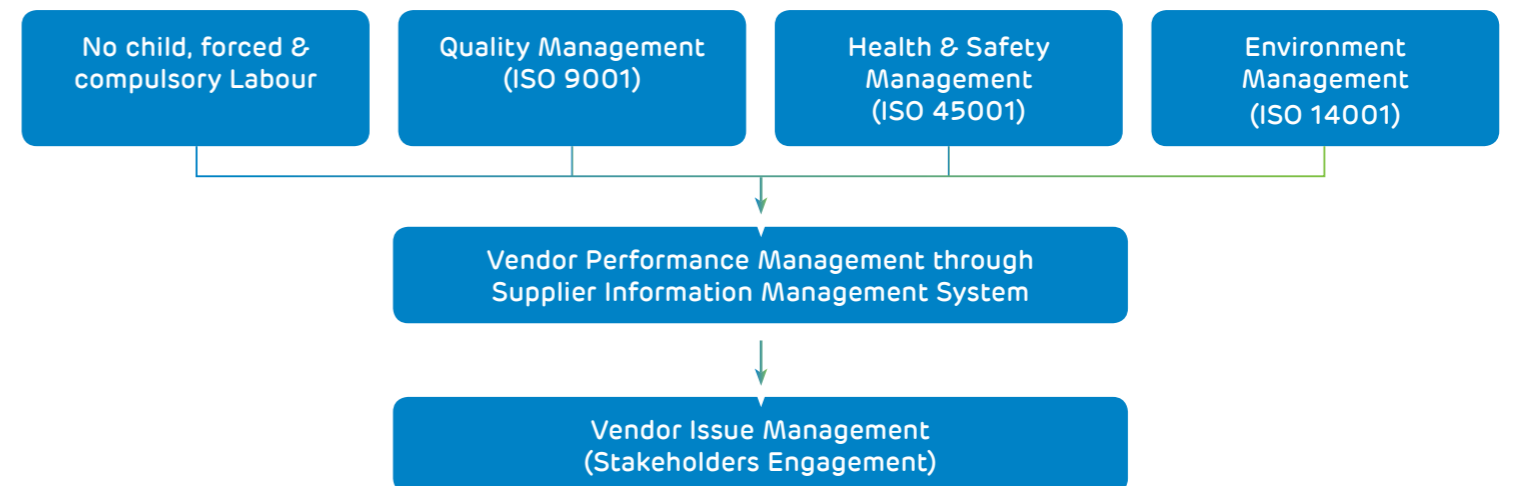


Capacity Building of Critical Vendors to Enhance their ESG Performance

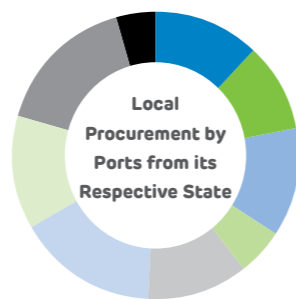
